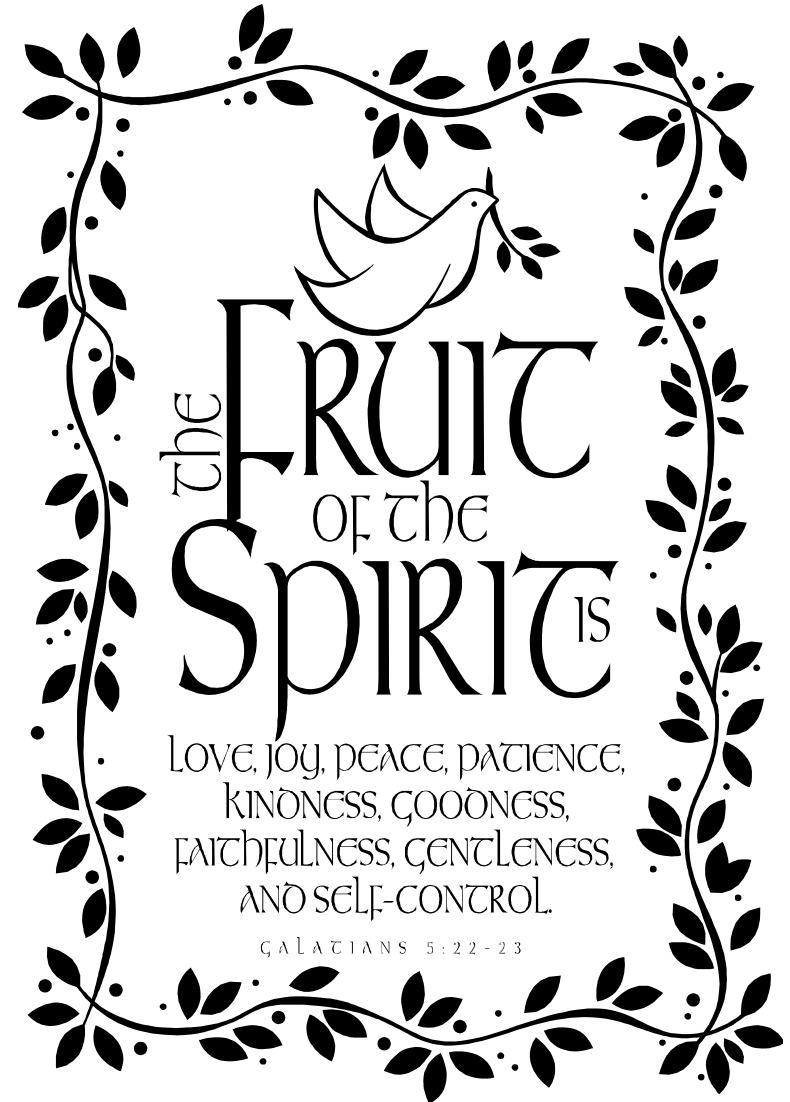
Empty Nesters
